The Westview School seeks an enthusiastic and experienced Development Director to lead and manage all aspects of its fundraising efforts. The successful candidate will work closely with the Head of School and Board of Trustees and collaborate with team members to raise \$500,000 annually.

- Serve as the lead staff for Westview's capital campaign
- Collaborate with Head of School, Board of Trustees, volunteers, and staff to achieve fundraising goals
- Create compelling case statements, collateral, and communication materials to support fundraising initiatives and donor stewardship
- Cultivate and maintain relationships with major gift donors and prospects
- Identify and pursue grant opportunities, including writing and submitting proposals
- Oversee the donor database, ensuring accurate records, timely acknowledgements, and effective reporting
- Work closely with the finance department to ensure accurate gift administration
- Provide regular updates on fundraising progress to the Head of School and Board of Trustees
- Continuously evaluate fundraising activities to maximize impact
- Prepare and manage the development department's annual budget (Westview Fund, Fundraising Luncheon, and any other events and projects as determined within the annual fundraising plan)
- Actively participate in and represent Westview at various school events
- Utilize fundraising and marketing platforms, including online tools
- Stay up to date on fundraising trends and best practices
- Reports to Head of School
- Other responsibilities as assigned
